



## Governors' Information and Duties

Governors at Oughtrington are fully involved in all aspects of school life. They provide excellent support and challenge to the Head Teacher and school in general. There are eighteen governors comprising of; five Parent Governors, one Head Teacher Governor, one Staff Governor, one Authority Governor and ten Co-Opted Governors (of which three are staff). One Governor is the Chair and one is the Vice Chair, voted by all Governors. The attendance at Full Governing Body Meetings during 2016 / 17 was 90% and in 2017 / 18 it was also 90%.

All committees have a Chair and a Vice Chair, voted by each committee.

All Governors also have a subject or area of responsibility and work with the lead teacher for that subject / area. Non-staff and non-parent governors are also paired with a year group. They are kept informed about the curriculum that takes place within that year group and are invited to attend special events and educational visits that their year group participate in. Governors remain with their year group as the cohort progress through school, thereby enabling them to fully understand and support the pupil's school experience.

No Governors have a business or financial interest in the school, apart from their governor role. Two Governors are on the Governing Body at Lymm High School.
