Citizenship Award



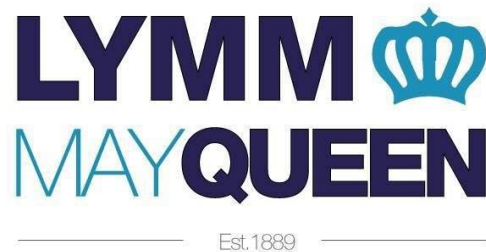
