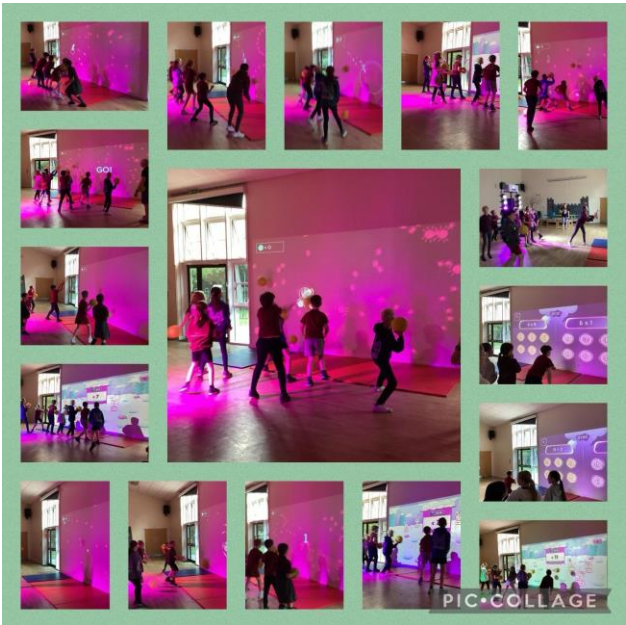
Sports Week
