School Meal/Snack

A reminder that if you are wanting to purchase either a school snack or meal for your child, then please be advised your ParentPay must be in credit at all times. Snacks are 25p per day (£1.25 per week) and lunch is £2.60 per day (£13.00 per week) - please check you account and bring up to date if in arrears with enough credit until the end of term, or provide your child with a snack / packed lunch if you are unable to do so.
