Information about Lymm Dickensian


This year's Lymm Dickensian event will be taking place on Saturday, 14th December 11am – 5pm.

Everybody Counts Programme for Warrington Families

Following **Every Body Counts** Launch last week, with your help, the Health and Wellbeing Team from The Foundation are now very keen to obtain valuable feedback from the families of pupils attending primary schools across Warrington.

Every Body Counts is a 12-week programme that has Physical activity, Mental wellbeing and Nutrition interwoven in its DNA to provide a bespoke programme for the young people and families of Warrington. Through our programme we will actively support families who are ready to make positive changes to all aspects of their health and well-being.

Our team wish to gather insight from local families to help us further understand the key challenges and barriers that they face in their day to day lives which can often mean that their endeavours to make health gains are challenging.

We've created a short questionnaire that we'd like sending out to the families of all primary schools in the town, to help provide us with a deeper understanding and to help tailor our programme content to address the main challenges that they face.
